German Placement Exam Instructions

The German Placement Exam is a way for the department to evaluate students' German proficiency and help the department place you in the appropriate language level for your skills.

You have **1 hour and 15 minutes** to complete the test. When taking the test, please do not use a dictionary. Answer spontaneously, as only an honest result will be helpful for you and your placement. We recommend that students utilize Google Chrome or Firefox to take the exam.

- 1. Log into Sakai using your Rutgers NetID.
- 2. In the left panel, click "Membership."
- 3. On top, click "Joinable Sites." A list of joinable sites will open.
- 4. In the search box on the top right, type "Camden German Placement" and click "Search."
- 5. Click "Join" under "Camden German Placement." A confirmation appears: "You are now a participant of the Camden German Placement."
- 6. Click "Home." The "Camden German Placement" Sakai site will appear among the course sites. (Click "More Sites" if it is not visible.)
- 7. Click on "Camden German Placement" on the top of the Sakai web page.
- 8. In the left panel, click "German Placement." Please read all instruction and review the Academic Integrity Policy.
- 9. Next Click on "Tests & Quizzes."
- 10. Click on the blue link "German Placement Exam."
- 11. Complete the test following the instructions.
- 12. At the end, click "Submit for Grading."

You will receive your score from the Office of New Students Programs within a week of completing the exam.
